

MASJIDE NOORUL ISLAM RE-OPENING 4th JULY 2020

Dear Respected Community,

It gives the Trustees and Committee of Masjide Noorul Islam, Blackburn great pleasure to hereby announce that Alhamdulillah our Masjid will re-open for congregational prayer from **Fajr Salaah (4:20am) on Saturday 4th July 2020** as set out in the recent Government announcements.

Masjide Noorul Islam will open to the general public with some restrictions in place so we kindly ask you to take note of the following guidelines that we will be operating the Masjid under:

- It is advised to wear a face mask to and from the masjid
- Please make wudhu from home
- Bring your own prayer mat and Qur'an
- Make sure you sanitize your hands, stations will be in place prior to entering the masjid
- Please bring a bag for your coat as coat hangers will not be in use
- DO NOT ATTEND the Masjid if you are displaying any COVID symptoms
- Children aged 10 and under are advised to remain at home
- Masjid will be operating at a reduced capacity
- 2 metre distancing will still be in place
- A one way system will continue to operate
- Masjid will open 15 minutes prior to Adhan and close 15 minutes after Salaah

All of the above will continue to be reviewed on a regular basis. Separate arrangements will be in place for Jumu'ah Salaah. Regular announcements will be made via the receiver system.

We humbly request all attendees to comply with the Government guidelines and respect the advice and guidance of the local volunteer enforcement teams on the premises to ensure everyone has an enjoyable experience when attending the Masjid.
